BAILEY'S IRISH CREAM LIQUOR

Deeann got this recipe from a former Air Force officer who is now in the restaurant business, and it's remarkably good! Making it is certainly cheaper than buying it, and it's fun too. This also makes a great gift: You can put it in Mason Jars, or buy a fancy air-tight bottle, either way people will love it! **Important note:** This recipe does not include any preservatives so it is not shelf stable, but will last up to 2 months in your refrigerator. Be sure to shake well before serving.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 3/4 Cups Irish Whiskey (I recommend Jameson)
- 1 Cup Heavy Whipping Cream
- 1 Can (14 oz.) Sweetened Condensed Milk
- 2 Tablespoons Hershey's Chocolate Syrup
- 2 Tablespoons Black Coffee
- 2 teaspoons Vanilla Extract

DIRECTIONS:

Place all ingredients in blender and mix on high for 20-30 seconds. Pour into bottles or Mason Jars and refrigerate (after sampling some of course!)
